**FORMER** Prime Minister Gordon Brown is still struggling to shake off the formal style which characterised his time in office.

Mr Brown was at Lochore Meadows Country Park, near Lochgelly, in Fife in his official capacity as local MP to open the Fife Outdoor Access Festival. Smiling broadly and chatting

easily to the organisers, he stood on a jetty on the banks of Loch Ore and cut through a green and white ribbon to declare the annual event open.

Mr Brown, 59, has been keeping a low profile since standing down as Prime Minister in May.

He has been spending more time with his wife Sarah and his sons in his Kirkcaldy and Cowdenbeath constituency.
